## **Important Guidelines for New Connection**

## Do's

- 1. Ensure that the construction work of the applied premises is completed and that no construction work is ongoing at the site.
- 2. **Provide a suitable space for meter installation** on the outer wall of the premises for hassle-free meter reading.
- 3. Ensure that the internal wiring of the premises is completed and that a cutout/MCB/ELCB is installed at a location adjacent to the meter installation point.
- 4. Ensure that the internal wiring complies with safety norms and adheres to the CEA (Measures Relating to Safety & Electric Supply) Regulations, 2023.
- 5. Ensure that the registered mobile number belongs to the applicant for direct communication and smooth processing of the application.
- 6. Ensure the Right of Way (ROW) is available for stringing the service cable and installing poles (if required for network extension).
- 7. Accurately fill out the application form, including but not limited to tariff details, load, name, supply address, PAN, and GST.
- 8. Verify all details mentioned in the Demand Note before making the payment.
- 9. Ensure the completeness and quality of scanned documents. Documents should be clearly visible and readable before uploading.
- 10. Stay updated on notifications or updates from TPNODL regarding your application.
- 11. **Inform TPNODL immediately** if any unforeseen circumstances arise that may hinder the processing of your application so that corrective actions can be taken promptly.
- 12. **Track your application status** by logging into the Mo Bidyut portal / TPNODL website using the registered mobile number/reference number.

## Don'ts

- 1. **Do not apply for a new connection if there are unpaid dues** against any existing connections associated with the applicant, its family members or applied premise. (*As per Clause 17 of Supply Code 2019*)
- 2. **Do not pay extra money or offer bribes** to any person including TPNODL officials or it's Business Associates without a valid receipt. If someone ask you extra money/bribe, report it immediately at **9124558988** or **vigilance.tpnodl@tpnodl.com**.
- 3. **Do not engage in electricity theft** by tapping the electricity line or transformer. *Electricity theft is a punishable offense under the Electricity Act.*
- 4. **Do not construct buildings underneath High-Tension or Low-Tension lines** without maintaining the required clearance.
